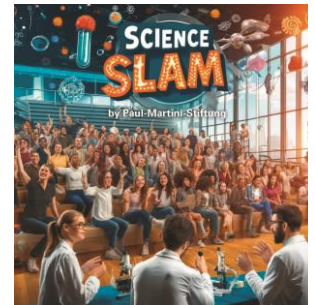

We are therefore calling for entries for the Science Slam on November 7th, 2025, on the topic **Neurological Diseases - Explore, Recognise, Treat.**

What's the PMS Autumn Symposium?

The two-day symposium is the renowned highlight of the PMS. Every year, leading minds from medicine, research, the pharmaceutical industry, and other professionals gather to discuss the latest developments in clinical pharmacology. Participation in the symposium is free of charge and open to everyone who is interested.



What's a science slam?

A science slam is a competition in which researchers present the results of their work in a compact, clear and highly entertaining way. Scientists become storytellers, inspiring and amazing the audience, making them laugh, but above all making them think.

What are the rules?

👉 **Your own stuff** - present content researched by yourself

🕒 **Make it short: 3-minute time limit** - anything is allowed

👉 **Don't be boring** - amaze the audience with your experiments, presentations, costumes and props

Who can apply?

Researchers at all levels from master's to research group leaders who enjoy entertaining an audience on the topic of **Neurological Diseases - Explore, Recognise, Treat.**

What counts?

Delivering to the point, originality, authenticity and the audience's applause.

Our Scientific Advisor Prof. Dr. Stefan Endres, LMU, and the Executive Board will select the entries. If you make it to the top six, the PMS will invite you to Berlin and the audience is yours to amaze. After each presentation, the audience will vote via "applausometer".

What's the prize?

The top three slammers will be awarded:

1st place: €300

2nd place: €200

3rd place: €100
